Border frustration with differing Colonial tariffs, inspired the 1893 Corowa Conference, at which it was resolved that a new Constitution should be approved by the voters in each Colony.

After 50 years of non-productive discussions, this '**Corowa Resolution**' ultimately led to the Commonwealth of Australia coming into existence in 1901'
